All User Units are now invited to apply for AYP Programme Fund, which will be assessed in September 2010, for running AYP activities.

In order to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of HKAYP, all applications approved in the coming AYP Programme Fund allocation **should bear the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Logo and Slogan** in their promotion materials if any. Details of the usage of the logo and slogan will be announced later.

As usual, applications will receive priority attention if they are related directly with the main themes in the corresponding period. The main themes for the coming batches are set as below for your kind attention:-

**For applications to be submitted in September 2010:**

- Promotional Activity for Celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of HKAYP; or
- Promotion of Dialogue and Mutual Understanding among Youth (International Year of Youth: Dialogue and Mutual Understanding)

**For applications to be submitted in March 2011:**

- Promotional Activity for Celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of HKAYP; or
- Environmental Conversation

The “Notes for Applicants” together with the “Additional Guidelines for applying AYP Programme Fund” are enclosed for your easy reference in making the application. Please note that for better allocation of resources, **participants of programmes supported by AYP Programme Fund are NOT eligible for applying SmarTone-Vodafone AYP International Exchange Programme Fund**, except those who are in need of financial assistance (for example, recipients of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA)).
