I am pleased to inform you that the Gold and Silver Award of the Hong Kong Award for Young People is listed at the third and fourth place respectively for consideration by 9 participating tertiary institutions.

In the meantime, please update your AYP participant records. It is also about time to recruit new participants and Student Leaders for the current year. The Student Leaders Training Camp has been scheduled for 28 to 30 October 2011. Details will be sent to you in due course.
